CALL TO TENDER Electric Submersible Pumps

Description

OMV Austria Exploration & Production GmbH (OMV) operates the Matzen oilfield in Austria, one of the country's longest-running assets, in production since the 1950s. As a mature field, Matzen faces the typical challenge of rising water-cut levels, which now exceed 96 %.

Electrical Submersible Pumps (ESPs) represent the third most widely used artificial lift method in the field, with 45 units currently installed, following sucker rod pumps (SRP) and gas lift. ESPs are primarily deployed in wells producing more than 200 m³/d of gross fluids or in wells with non-vertical casing profiles.

In line with OMV's procurement policies, the company is launching a tender to select one or two ESP suppliers. The duration of the contract will be 3 years with possible 2-year extension upon mutual agreement and supplier performance.

The tender scope includes the design, supply, and delivery of ESP systems—covering both surface and downhole equipment—as well as spare parts. It also encompasses field services on a call-out basis. OMV reserves the right to enlarge the contract to other projects in OMV Austria E&P.

Potential suppliers must comply with all applicable Austrian and EU regulations, directives standards, and codes governing ESP operations. OMV engages external auditors (e.g., TÜV Austria) to verify full compliance with these requirements. Under no circumstances may the supplier charge OMV for any costs associated with achieving or demonstrating regulatory compliance.

Evaluation: OMV will evaluate both technical and commercial aspects in an equal manner.

The deadline for application is Thursday, the 11th of May 2026.
